

## **Receive Update on the Community Power Plan Development**

- At the December 2021 CAC meeting, the committee appointed Committee members Carolyn Scofield and Matt Vasilakis to assist in the recruitment of the CPP development firm.
- CAC members helped staff review proposals and interview three firms.
- In March 2022, the CAC extended the appointments to join the CPP project team
- In April 2022, a contract between Calpine Energy Solutions ("Calpine") and Arup Consulting ("Arup") was executed.
- The project was officially started in May with a Kickoff meeting on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022.
- In next couple of weeks, the project team will be reaching out to CAC members to gather input on effective engagement strategies in your communities.
