SDCP's Current Enrollment Statistics:

Enrollments

- By the end of 2022, we will be serving about 770,000 accounts across the region, making us the second largest community choice aggregator in California.
- Our participation rate remains above 95% in terms of accounts and load.

Net Energy Metering (NEM)/Solar Customers

- We currently serve over 33,000 NEM accounts. We expect an average enrollment of roughly 8,500 NEM accounts per month from June 2022 through January 2023.

Power100

- Over 25,000 accounts are enrolled in Power100, receiving 100% renewable and carbon-free electricity.
- The energy used by these Power100 customers is equivalent to removing over 22,000 gasoline-powered passenger vehicles from the road for one year.

The big switch: More than 700,000 electric customers begin moving from SDG&E to a community energy program
