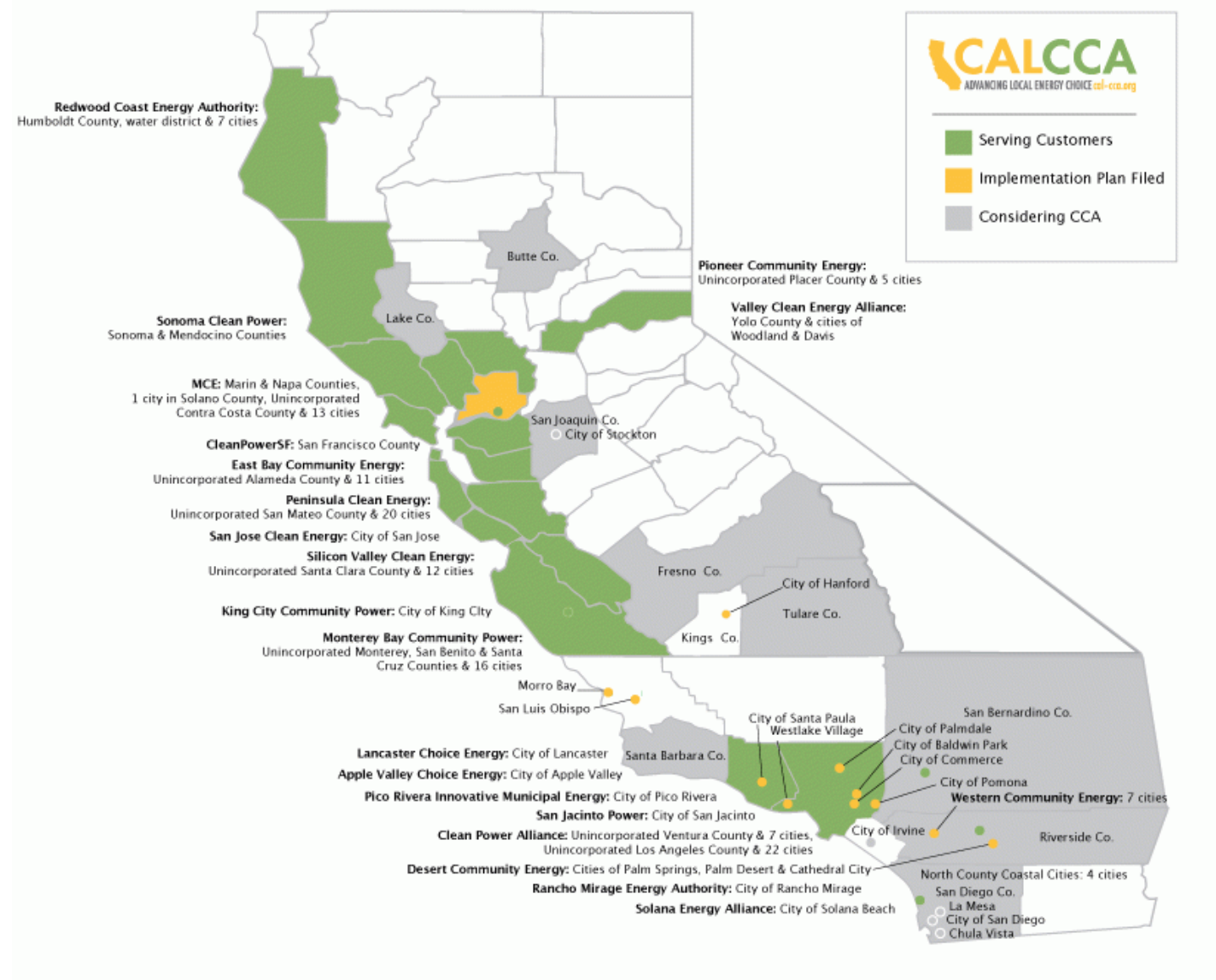

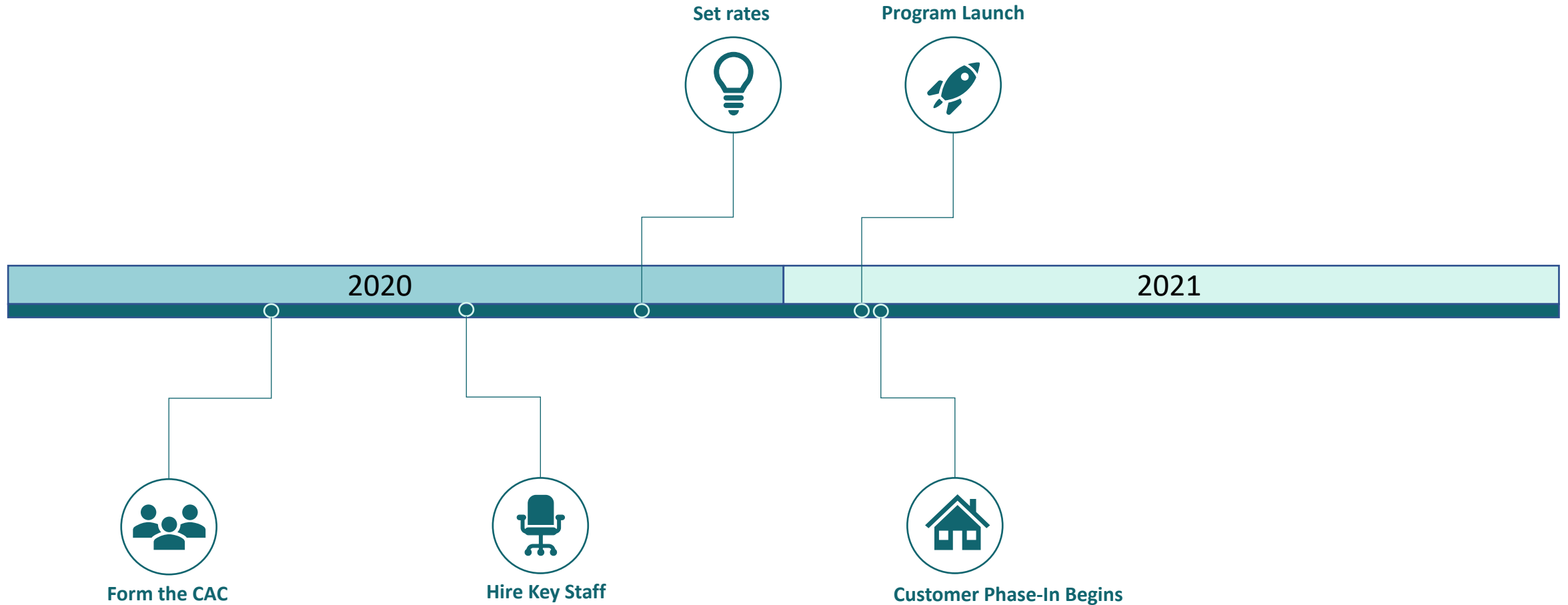
Community Choice throughout California



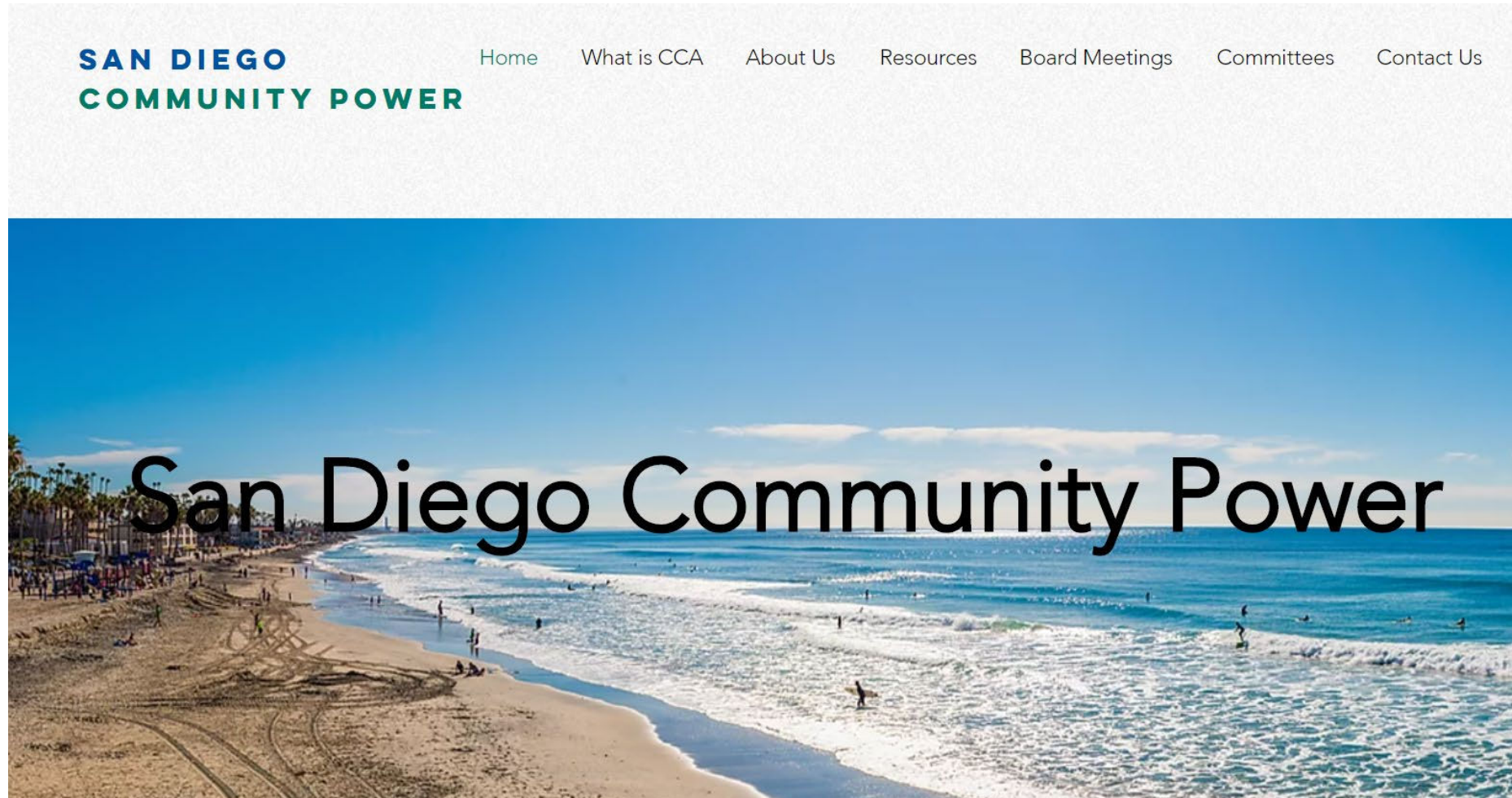
