However, SDG&E appears to be trying to manipulate this requirement to their advantage to extract what limited financial resources SDCP has by bloating the bond to handicap the program before it even begins serving customers. This is yet another example of SDG&E's aggressive actions to stymie and undermine San Diego Community Power from having a successful launch. Instead of being an honest partner, they are wasting valuable SDCP time and resources on dead end efforts to kill community choice energy. We cannot let their profit motivations thwart our climate and clean energy goals. Our region is counting on the board's leadership to ensure a successful launch of SDCP. We urge the board to take a strong position in opposition to SDG&E's antics and protect public power in our region.
