Eligible hydroelectric facilities are defined in the Green-e® Renewable Energy Standard for Canada and the United States (<http://www.green-e.org/standard>) and include facilities certified by the Low Impact Hydropower Institute (LIHI) (www.lowimpacthydro.org) or EcoLogo (www.ecologo.org); and facilities comprised of a turbine in a pipeline or a turbine in an irrigation canal.

For comparison, the current average mix of resources supplying San Diego Gas & Electric ("SDG&E") service area includes: Coal 0%, Nuclear 0%, Oil 0%, Natural Gas 59%, Hydroelectric 0%, and Other 0%. This resource mix was prepared in accordance with the Power Source Disclosure Program.

The average home in San Diego Community Power/San Diego Gas & Electric service area uses 372 kWh per month. This is based on SDG&E and Community Power's jointly published rate comparison for TOU-DR-1 rate schedules as of January 1, 2026.
